#### Community Update—Site Establishment

Hello Neighbours,

You may have seen the hoarding and gates being installed to the new entrances on Highams Lane..

We wanted to keep you updated with what works we have been carrying out and what is planned for the coming period. Since November 2021 the project team have been based in temporary cabins on site carrying out procurement and enabling works. In anticipation of our main works which commenced at the end of February, we have been undertaking investigative excavations, removing the grass and top soil from the construction areas and constructing the basis of the roadways to ease movement around site.

Our main accommodation block foundations have been constructed and the modular accommodation has been installed in February. There will be early connections made to the existing utility networks and we will be installing our temporary utilities to supply the site which include water and electricity.

There is a lane closure scheduled towards the end of April to allow SSE to undertake works in Highams Lane, a further notification will be sent to outline works required.

We will be hosting our Meet the contractor event on 28th March. Please feel free to drop into the Half Moon Church Rd, Windlesham GU20 6BN between 19.30 until 21.00 where you will have the opportunity to meet the Mace team and find out more about the project from Mace and Gordon Murray Automotive.
